This Assurance of Voluntary 4 Compliance shall not be considered an admission of a violation of the Unlawful Trade Practices 5 Act by Respondents for any purpose. 6 5. 7 Respondents understand and agree that this Assurance of Voluntary Compliance applies 8 to Respondents, Respondents' principals, officers, directors, agents, employees, or 9 representatives if their actions are directed, formulated, and controlled by Respondents, to any 10 parent or subsidiary corporation, and to any affiliated or successor organization. A successor 11 organization of ALE PAC is defined as any federal political action committee in which William 12 Tierney serves as a principal of the successor organization. 13 6. 14-Respondents recognize the requirements the Oregon Unlawful Trade Practices Act, ORS 15 646.601 et seq., including the prohibition on engaging in unlawful telephone solicitations 16 prohibited by ORS 646.561 to 646.565 et seq. Respondents agree to obey Oregon's Unlawful 17 Trade Practices Act, ORS 646.605 to ORS 646.656, and to refrain from engaging in unlawful 18 telephone solicitations prohibited by ORS 646.561 to 646.565 et seq. 19 7. 20 Respondents understand and agree that, in addition to any other sanctions which may be 21 imposed under this Assurance of Voluntary Compliance or under the law, subsequent willful 22 violations of the terms of this Assurance of Voluntary Compliance may result in civil penalties 23 of up to \$25,000 for each violation, and such further relief as the court, under the circumstances, 24 may deem appropriate. 25

20	Assurance to a General Judgment, Money Award under ORS 646.632(2) without notice to
21	Respondents if a payment is not timely made. Respondents agree that a copy of the General

23	address following Respondents' signatures.
